

Medication



Parents are encouraged to work with their physicians to schedule medication administration before or after school hours. When this is not possible, in accordance with State of Arizona, Bureau of Child Care Licensing, medication prescribed by your physician must be stored and administered in the Starting Blocks Academy Office.

Medication must be in the original container with the child's name on the label, as well as the prescription number, name of the medication, dosage and expiration dates. A *Medication Consent Form* must be completed to accompany the medication. If your child has a chronic health problem that will require an extended use of medication, a *Medical Information Request Form (MIR)* will need to be completed and signed by your health care provider prior to your child's entry into Starting Blocks Academy. [This form are provided by the Starting Blocks Academy Office.] Upon receipt of the MIR, a Health Care Plan will be created and signed by the Starting Blocks Academy administration and Starting Blocks Academy teacher, and the parent.
